





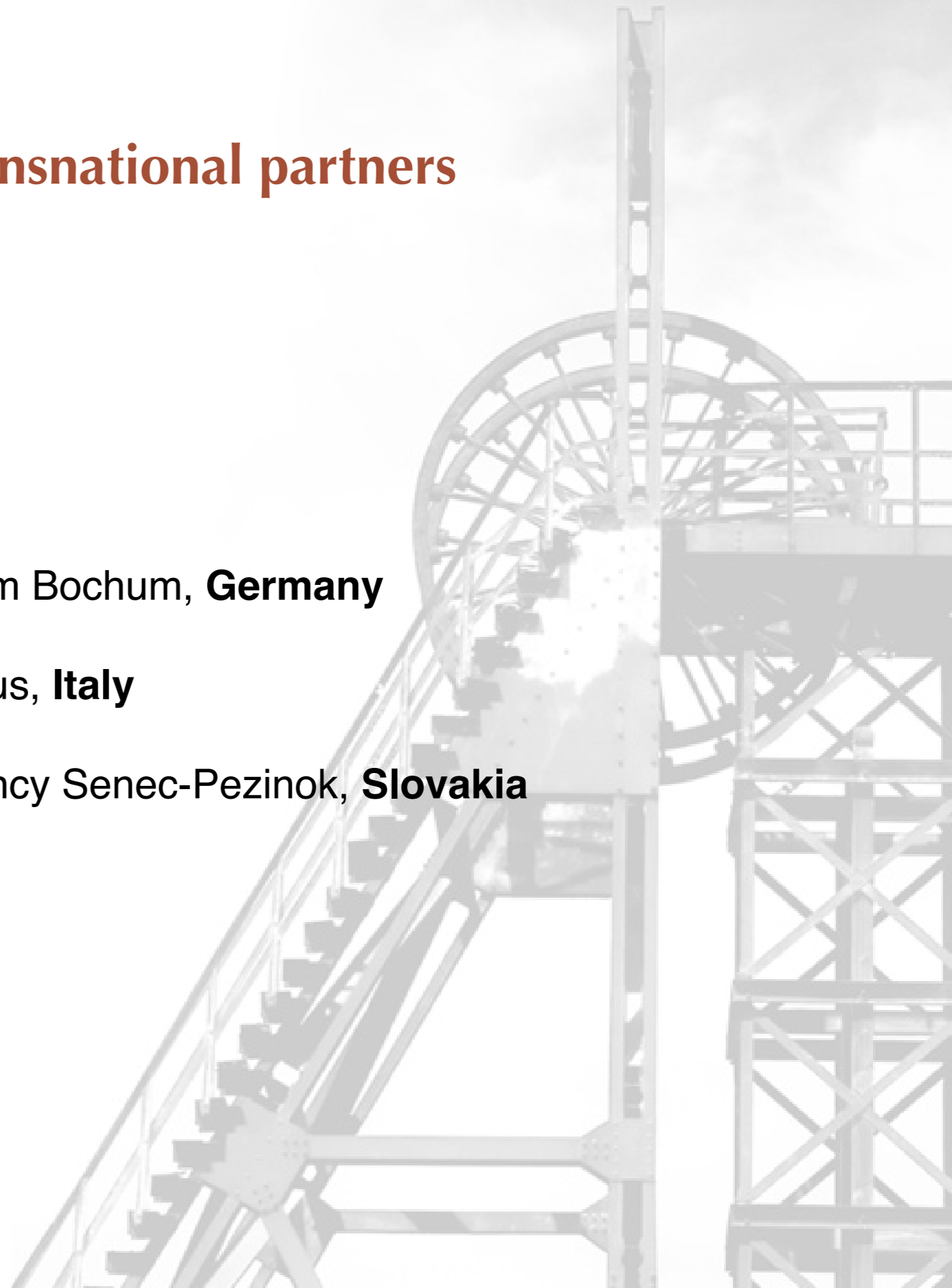

- Benefit the **discussion and exchange of experiences** based in retrieving criterion by assigning ideas and new techniques.

-Promote and disseminate the knowledge of a commonly unknown and underestimated mean of expression such as the mining industrial **heritage**.

- Dissemination of the historical and cultural expressions -which have remained after mining works ended- by using **new technologies** in order to reach a higher number of citizens.

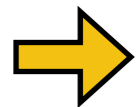

Activities

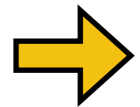

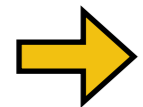

The creative workshop will lead to an **operative workshop**. It will be based on the the previous report made to make a series of technical and physical improvements on the proposed mining pilot area to ensure its future contemplation and enjoyment.



During the seventh and tenth month of the project, there will be two **transnational seminars**, held in two different towns, and will last 3 days each. The target of these seminars is to identify and exchange good practices between the co-organizers of the project. The seminars will welcome as well other european organizations with relevant trajectory in enhancing the mining heritage as it really deserves.
